This link is live from Wednesday 5th February. You will initially be able to buy up to 3 tickets per family, and we ask that pre-school age children do not attend, as this event is not really suitable for them.

Please note that parking is limited at Kings Road United Reformed Church and we would ask that you consider using public transport, walking or car sharing wherever possible. Vehicles are only permitted to park in the designated parking areas. Please considerate of other road users and local residents when parking. There will be a limited number of spaces available on the coach which will be leaving school at the earlier time of 8.50am. These will cost an additional £5 a person and will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis. Please see Mrs Kiln in the school office to secure a coach place.
