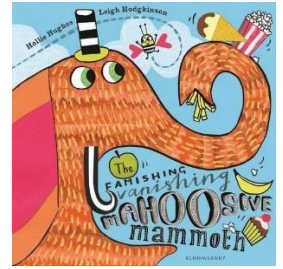


Reception Home Learning

Competition - This year our whole school competition is to decorate a piece of fruit or vegetable as your favourite book character. We would like all children to take a photograph of their completed character and upload to tapestry or send to class email address by Monday 8th March . There will be prizes!	
Friday 5th March - Dress up as your favourite book character! Please upload photos for us to see!	
Snuggle up and read/share your favourite story you have at home. Can you draw a picture and label your favourite character from the story?	
World book day scavenger hunt (see website for video and recording sheet).	
Use the story telling prompt cards to make up and tell your own story (see attached). Pick: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A character (green card) • An item (orange card) • A setting (blue card) 	
Listen to 'The Girl and the Dinosaur' and 'Ninja Nan' - stories by Hollie Hughes. Read by Mrs Dearle and Miss Price. (see website)	

Story - Princess Swashbuckle	✓
Listen to the story 'Princess Swashbuckle' by Hollie Hughes. Read by Miss Maynard.	
Paint or draw a picture of Princess Swashbuckle (or one of the other characters in the story). Describe and talk about the character.	
Design your own treasure map.	
Draw, paint or use collage to create a new flag for Princess Swashbuckle. There is a pirate flag resource you can use if you would like to.	
Make a pirate hat!	
Make your own pirate telescope!

Story - The Famishing Vanishing Mahoosive Mammoth	✓
Listen to the story 'The Famishing Vanishing Mahoosive Mammoth' by Hollie Hughes. Read by Mrs Dorrington.	
Paint or draw a picture of The Mahoosive Mammoth. Describe and talk about the character.	
Design a menu/meal for the Mammoth by drawing pictures, by writing a list or you could even use play/real food.	
Create a game or an activity that you could do with Mammoth, that will take his mind off of food!	
The fly is the Mammoths best friend. Can you draw a picture/write a letter to someone in your family or a friend, to tell them why you love them and what makes them special.
