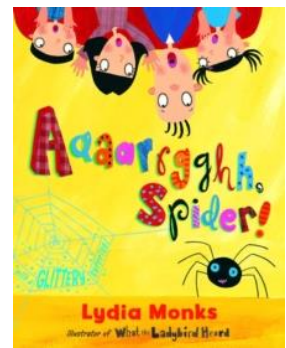

Green Word PowerPoints (converted to PDF)

Please find attached the two green word documents for this week - 'Green Words Set 1 - 1.3 words part 1' and 'Green Words Set 2 'ow' words' - **see attached**

Remember, these words are for the children to practise reading and then spelling them after if they fancy a further challenge.

At first the children will need to 'Fred Talk' the words and then read them. Then they move on to 'Fred in their head' (sounding out in their head) and saying the word. The overall aim is for the children to be able to read the words quickly on-sight.

Please continue to recap Set 1 sounds. Practise recognising and saying the sounds and writing the letters correctly (use your set 1 sound books from Parents' Evening to help you with the rhymes).

Story

This week our story is 'Aaaarrgghh Spider' by Lydia Monks. You can watch a video of the story on Tapestry read by Miss Maynard.

Below are a range of ideas you could do linked to 'Aaaarrgghh Spider'. There are also some resources to support some of these ideas - please see other attachments. We hope these help.

- Listen to and discuss the story 'Aaaarrgghh Spider'. Draw and label which minibeast you would like to have as a pet.
- Create your own spider. You could use a paper plate and pipe cleaners. Or you could paint, draw, collage a picture of a spider. You could even make a spider web using a paper plate. - **see attached instructions**.
- Learn about the life cycle of a spider - **see attached PowerPoint**. Can you draw and label the four stages?
- Learn and recite the nursery rhyme 'Incy Wincy Spider' - **see attached video**.
- Complete the spider dot-to-dot - numbers 1-20 - **see attached**
- Work on your cutting skills with the Incy Wincy Spider split pin activity - **see attached**. You could then use your spider to help you sing the nursery rhyme! Can you make any other props to help with the rhyme too?

Topic

- Play 'What am I?' - minibeast description game with Mrs Little - **see attached video**.
- Learn about minibeast habitats with Mrs Todd - **see attached video**. You could then complete minibeasts and their habitats activity worksheet - **see attached**.

This week's theme is '**Climate**'. You could always draw a picture and write about what you have learnt or you could try one of their makes or experiments they do and share them with us.

Other Regular Activities To-Do

- Read your books - you can also access Oxford Reading Buddy (login details on the front of your child's reading record book).

- Practise reading your High Frequency words (in the red book in your child's book bag and full document upload to Tapestry and sent via email last week).
- Practise writing your name independently (work on your first name and then your surname) - remember to form your letters correctly (use your set 1 sound books from Parents' Evening to help you with the rhymes).
- Practise recognising numbers to 10 (move on to 20 when ready).
- Practise ordering numbers to 10 (move on to 20 when ready).
- Practise counting up to 5/10/20 objects carefully - remember to move them to count them.
