Reading	Read your RWI home book or gold reading book for 10 minutes. Write down any words you do not know the meaning of and try to find out what they mean.

English	As part of our end of term learning, we would like all the children to write a paragraph about their hopes and aspirations for the future. E.g. joining a new football team, learning a new instrument, joining a new out of school club (sport or otherwise). Please encourage the children to explain why they would like to do it and with whom.	Please present this on paper with their name and class.
Science	Activity- Look at a microhabitat (a small-scale environment within an ecosystem), e.g. a patch of grass, under a log, under rocks and stones or a flowerbed. Identify how many minibeasts you can see and list as a tally chart or total number. E.g. Ants 6 Spiders 3 Try a second microhabitat and repeat tally chart/total number.	Please present this on paper with their name and class.
Grammar	Using this image of the Amazon rainforest, Write 3-4 descriptive sentences. Remember to add adjectives, adverbs, similes and correct punctuation. E.g. The huge green leaves dangled gently into the deep dark water.
