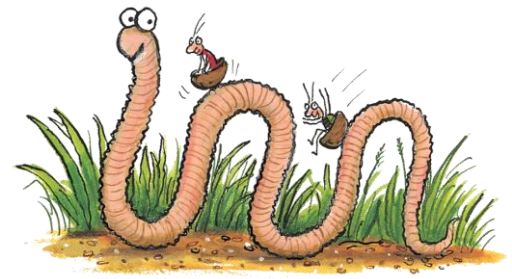

Please find attached the two green word documents for this week - 'Green Words Set 1 - 1.2 words part 1' and 'Green Words Set 2 'ee' words' - **see attached**

Remember, these words are for the children to practise reading and then spelling them after if they fancy a further challenge.

At first the children will need to 'Fred Talk' the words and then read them. Then they move on to 'Fred in their head' (sounding out in their head) and saying the word. The overall aim is for the children to be able to read the words quickly on-sight.

Please continue to recap Set 1 sounds. Practise recognising and saying the sounds and writing the letters correctly (use your set 1 sound books from Parents' Evening to help you with the rhymes).

PE - Home Activities - Week 5

This week there are 5 home PE activities, one for each day. These are 'Daily Walk', 'Alphabet Fitness', 'Yoga', 'Magic Carpet' and 'I Spy' - **see attached**.

Story

This week our story is, 'Superworm'. You can watch a video of the story on Tapestry read by Mrs Little.

Below are a range of ideas you could do linked to 'Superworm'. There are also some resources to support some of these ideas - please see other attachments. We hope these help.

- Can you paint or make your own super minibeast?
- After painting or making your own super minibeast can you write about what your super minibeast can do?
- Think about all the ways that Superworm helps different animals in the book. Can you create a new page for the book with Superworm helping another animal?
- Can you try to memorise the chant from the story Superworm? Once you know the chant from memory, can you record yourself saying it?
- Can you use a computer or a laptop to draw a picture linked with 'Superworm'? Can you try typing a word or phrase to go with it? Don't forget to type your name so we know who's work it is!
- Using playdough, can you make some Superworms and put them in order by length?
- Can you order the story of Superworm? - For a challenge, can you write words or phrases to go with some of the pictures? - **see attached**
- Can you make a fact file about worms? Can you use books, the internet or the fact cards (**see attached**) to find out some facts about worms. Draw a picture or print a picture of a worm and write some facts to go with it.
- You may like to have a go at creating your own edible 'Mud and Worms' - **see attached**
 - Can you record a video of you retelling the story/part of the story or talking about your favourite part of the story? - 'Superworm'
 - Make stick puppets to retell the story of 'Superworm'
 - Thought Bubbles - Can you draw a picture and write a thought bubble for Superworm? A thought bubble shows what a character is thinking - **see attached**
 - Can you draw/paint a picture of your favourite part of 'Superworm'?
 - After you have drawn or painted your favourite part of the story, can you write a word or short phrase/sentence about your favourite part? Use your sounds to write independently (every child received a sound mat in their book bags following the Phonics Workshop)

Diary of your Plant - continue

Continue to fill in your diary to show what is happening to the plants you have planted? You could draw a picture and write a sentence every few days or once a week. The sentences could be: It has a root. I can see the stem. It has 1 leaf. It has got taller.

You can always continue to watch Maddie and Greg's 'Let's Go Live' show as you will always learn new things. They are broadcast through Maddie Moate's YouTube channel on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 11am.

This week's theme is 'Food'. You could always draw a picture and write about what you have learnt or you could try one of their makes or experiments they do and share them with us.

Other Regular Activities To-Do

- Read your books - you can also access Oxford Reading Buddy (login details on the front of your child's reading record book).
- Practise reading your High Frequency words (in the red book in your child's book bag and full document upload to Tapestry and sent via email last week).
- Practise writing your name independently (work on your first name and then your surname) - remember to form your letters correctly (use your set 1 sound books from Parents' Evening to help you with the rhymes).
- Practise recognising numbers to 10 (move on to 20 when ready).
- Practise ordering numbers to 10 (move on to 20 when ready).
- Practise counting up to 5/10/20 objects carefully - remember to move them to count them
