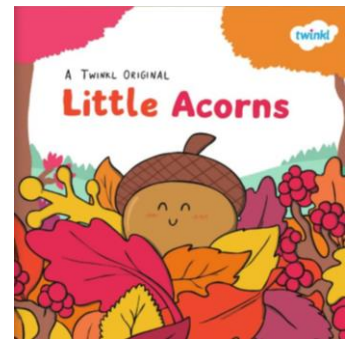

Daily Maths

This week the focus in Maths is comparing mass and comparing capacity.

This Week's Set 2 Speed Sounds and Spelling Videos:

Monday - ir (as in twirl, girl)

Tuesday - ou (as in shout, out)

Wednesday - oy (as in toy, boy)

Thursday - Recap Set 2 sounds (we think they will put up 'ay' again)

Friday - Recap Set 2 sounds (we think they will put up 'ee' again)

PLEASE NOTE:

As of Thursday 21st January, we will be uploading 2 extra Read Write Inc videos (daily on Tapestry and the school website) for the children to watch and participate with each day after watching the sound and spelling videos on the YouTube channel. One of the videos will be a 'Word Time!' session and the other will be a reading session. These would be the usual activities which follow the 'Speed Sounds' and spelling sessions in a Read Write Inc lesson at school as of January in Reception, when the children are grouped. A whole Read Write Inc lesson at school would last for 50 minutes each day.

We will email you by Wednesday 20th January to say which video is best suited for your child to watch and participate with each day.

Please continue to recap Set 1 sounds. Practise recognising and saying the sounds and writing the letters correctly (use your set 1 sound books from Parents' Evening to help you with the rhymes).

PE - Home Activities - Week 3

This week's home PE activities are 'Traffic Lights' and 'Spider's Web' - **see attached**.

Story

This week we have two stories, 'After the Storm' and 'Little Acorns'. You can watch a video of each story on Tapestry read by Miss Maynard and Mrs Todd.

Below are a range of ideas you could do linked to 'After the Storm' and 'Little Acorns'. There are also some resources to support some of these ideas - please see other attachments. We hope these help.

- Watch the 'Life Cycle of an Oak Tree' PowerPoint video (**see attached**). Can you order the pictures or draw the different stages of the life cycle of an oak tree - **see attached**.
- After watching PowerPoint above, can you try the 'Life Cycle of an Oak Tree' PowerPoint Quiz?
- Watch the 'An Oak Tree in All Seasons' PowerPoint video (**see attached**). Can you draw/paint/collage a picture of an oak tree in your chosen season? You could challenge yourself to draw/paint/collage an oak tree in all four of the seasons.
- Make stick puppets of the characters for the story 'After the Storm' - Percy the Park Keeper, badger, fox, rabbits, hedgehog and mice.
- Thought Bubbles - Can you write a thought bubble for Little Acorn? A thought bubble shows what a character is thinking e.g. It is too cold. I am starting to sprout. - **see attached**.

- Speech Bubbles - Can you write a speech bubble for Percy the Park Keeper? A speech bubble shows what the character is saying e.g. "Oh no, what has happened?", "We will build a new tree house." You might like to draw or paint a picture of Percy too for the speech bubble to go with. - **see attached**

- Design a Tree House - Can you design and/or make a tree house for the animals in the story 'After the Storm'? You could draw/paint or even make your tree house using construction kits or from junk modelling.

- Can you draw/paint a picture of your favourite part of 'After the Storm' and 'Little Acorns'?

- After you have drawn or painted your favourite part of the story, can you write a word or short phrase/sentence about your favourite part? Use your sounds to write independently (every child received a sound mat in their book bags following the Phonics Workshop)

- Can you record a video of you retelling the story/part of the story or talking about your favourite part of the story? - 'After the Storm' and 'Little Acorns'

Topic

Diary of your Plant

Can you make a diary to show what is happening to the plants you have planted? You could draw a picture and write a sentence every few days or once a week. The sentences could be: It has a root. I can see the stem. It has 1 leaf. It has got taller.

Other Regular Activities To-Do

- Read your books - you can also access Oxford Reading Buddy (login details on the front of your child's reading record book).
- Practise reading your High Frequency words (in the red book in your child's book bag and full document upload to Tapestry and sent via email last week).
- Practise writing your name independently (work on your first name and then your surname) - remember to form your letters correctly (use your set 1 sound books from Parents' Evening to help you with the rhymes).
- Practise recognising numbers to 10 (move on to 20 when ready).
- Practise ordering numbers to 10 (move on to 20 when ready).
- Practise counting up to 5/10/20 objects carefully - remember to move them to count them
