- Home Learning Challenge sheet 'Seaside' - see attached
- Can you design your own sandcastle? You may want to draw/paint or make this. Can you write about your sandcastle? E.g. It has a 4 towers and 1 flag.
- Can you look at the pictures of the beach and write some phrases and simple sentences to go with them? - see attached
- If you go for a walk around the sea wall, can you draw a picture in the sand or collect some materials e.g. sand, shells and seaweed and create your own picture back at home?
- Can you choose an animal you might find in a rock pool, e.g. a crab, a starfish, whelks, shrimp, small fish, then use the internet (with adult support) and find out about your

chosen animal? Once you have found out about the animal can you write up 2 or 3 facts about it?

- Can you draw/paint/make (junk modelling/clay/playdough/salt dough) an animal or an object found at the beach?

- **Challenge** - Can you find out about what it was like to go to the seaside in the past? What is the same? Has anything changed? Can you draw or write about what you find out?
