Maths Home Learning Challenges - Solving Problems and Talking about Position

- Home Learning Challenge sheet 'The Gingerbread Man' - see attached
- Can you create a wanted poster for the Gingerbread Man?
- Can you write a THOUGHT bubble for each character in the story? - What might the characters be thinking? E.g. I want to eat the gingerbread man. How am I going to cross this river? - use your sounds to write independently - see attached
- Can you write a speech bubble for some of the characters in the story? - see attached
- Can you record a video of you retelling the story/part of the story or talking about your favourite part of the story?
- The Gingerbread Man Wordsearch - see attached
- Can you make and decorate a gingerbread man?
- Can you design your own Gingerbread Man? - see attached
- Can you write a description of the Gingerbread Man - e.g. He has three buttons.

- Make stick puppets or masks
- Make the characters you have made to retell the story
- Can you put the pictures of the story in the right order? - see attached OR you may want to draw your own pictures, cut them out and put them in the right order.
- Order the pictures and write a sentence for each part of the story - use your sounds to write independently - see attached
- Can you write the story or part of the story - using your sounds to help you and draw a picture/pictures to go with it?
- Can you draw/paint your favourite part of the story and write a sentence about it?
- Can you put the Gingerbread Men in to height order - see attached
- The Gingerbread Man Addition to 10 - see attached
